



Supply List for Specialty Feet & Attachments

(Part 1)

If you don't own all or any of these feet/attachments, this is a great opportunity to get familiar with how they work. And if you don't have the fabrics and supplies ready, you'll have the replay link to watch at your convenience.

GATHERING FOOT

3" x 44" (width of fabric) quilting weight cotton

5" x 22" (Approx.) quilting weight cotton

PIPING FOOT

I will demo a zipper insertion and piping

#3 (dress weight) zipper; I'll use a 14" zipper

8" (width) x 18" (length) pre-quilted or upholstery weight fabric

The zipper should be at least 4" longer than the fabric edge to which it's being attached.

20" length 3 – 5mm filler cord (most brands have 2 different piping feet channel widths)

16" (length) x 2" wide bias-cut fabric to cover filler cord

(2) 6" x 16 fabric to sandwich piping

BEADING FOOT

12" string of 4 -6mm beads

Check your owner's manual or the instruction insert for recommended maximum size beads

4" x 15" cotton fabric

BLIND STITCH (BLIND HEM) FOOT

6" x 12" cotton, linen or blend fabric; press a 1 ½" hem

Pintucks: 3" x 12" strip of cotton

CORDING FOOT

(2) 3 ½" x 12" quilting weight cotton

(2) 16" lengths of 26-gauge wire; 28-gauge works also
